For FSMQ, the highest grade available is a grade A

- 18.7% of results were Grade 9 – our best ever in public examinations since the new 9-1 grading came in 2017, and also better than Centre Assessed Grades 2020
- Over a third (34%) of results were the top Grades 8 or 9– our best ever in public examinations since the new 9-1 grading came in 2017, and also better than Centre Assessed Grades 2020
- Over half (53.6%) of results were Grades 7 to 9 – our best ever in public examinations since the new 9-1 grading came in 2017
- Over a third of pupils (35%) achieved 100% Grades 6-9
- Over two-fifths (42%) of pupils achieved grades 8 or 9 in Mathematics
- Almost two-thirds (58%) of pupils achieved grades 7-9 in English Language
- Across Biology, Chemistry and Physics, 37% of results were the top Grades 8 or 9
