- Over a third (33.4%) of results were the top Grades 8 or 9
- Nearly half (47%) of grades achieved a 7 or above, which is more than double of the national average
- 15.2% of results were the highest grade 9
- 87% of all grades awarded were grade 5 or above
- Over a fifth of all pupils achieved grades 9 or 8 in at least seven different subjects
- Over two-fifths (41%) of maths grades were graded 9 or 8
- Two-fifths (40%) of English Language grades were 9 or 8
- Across all three Sciences (Biology, Chemistry and Physics), 21% of results are awarded were the top grade 9
